

Foodservices Supervisor
Food Services Division, Yukon University
Arctic Winter Games 2026
March 7 – March 14, 2026

Foodservice supervisors oversee front-of-house teams in assembling, serving, sanitation, customer support, and safety compliance, tailored for high-volume settings such as the Arctic Winter Games. Key duties emphasize FoodSafe practices, staff leadership, athlete assistance, and efficient operations.

Key Duties

- Supervise and direct foodservice workers in assembling and portioning food items per recipes and FoodSafe practices or as directed and ensure serving as instructed.
- Coordinate serving of food and beverages, manage serving stations, respond to athlete questions/inquiries, and provide assistance or guidance.
- Address escalated inquiries from athletes; if unable to answer regarding ingredients or dietary concerns, follow up with the Chef lead in the kitchen for accurate information, and ensure workers direct unresolved issues to the foodservice supervisor promptly.
- Oversee safe operation of front-of-house equipment, maintain service lines with proper stocking and setup, and ensure equipment maintenance.
- Direct cleaning and sanitizing of workstations, dishes, utensils, and dining areas to comply with health regulations and FoodSafe standards.
- Monitor inventory, rotate stock, manage waste disposal, address shortages or issues, and foster collaboration among team members.

Foodservice Supervisors require at least 2-4 years of front-of-house experience in high-volume service environments, including team coordination and customer-facing operations. Candidates must hold FOODSAFE Level 1 certification (or equivalent) with demonstrated skills in managing serving stations, resolving athlete inquiries, and ensuring smooth workflow. Knowledge of dietary guidance, allergen protocols, and crowd management during events is essential. Previous supervisory roles in campus dining, catering, or sports events represent a strong asset.
