Prerequisites: BIOL 101 and 102

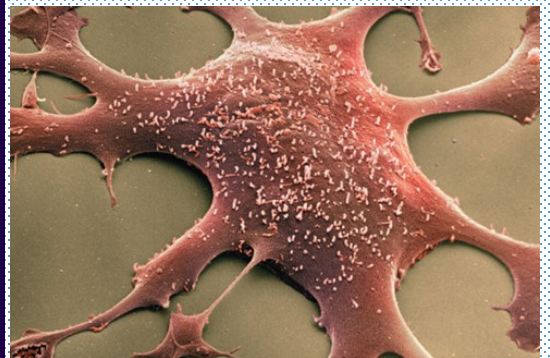
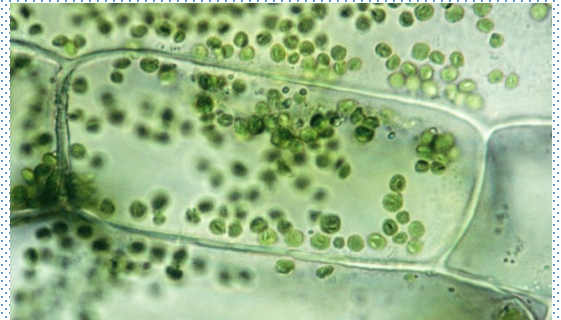
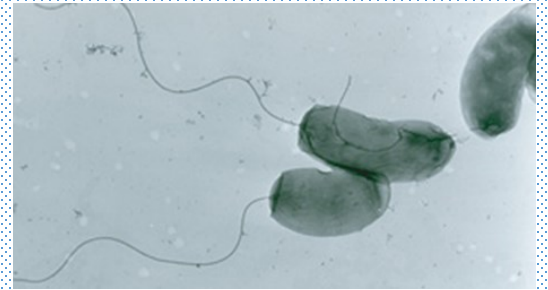
