Reporting to the Coordinators and Lead Facilitators, summer camp facilitators will work in teams of 2-3 to plan and deliver safe and enriching week-long summer camps in Whitehorse and Yukon's rural communities. Facilitators will also have the opportunity to mentor high school facilitators in training.

- Post-secondary students (or recent graduates) interested in the following disciplines: Sciences, Engineering, Mathematics, Education, Computer Science, Arts, Trades;
- Teaching experience and/or previous experience working with youth is an asset;
