Yukon University Animal Care Committee (YukonU ACC) is an animal ethics committee established under the Policies and Guidelines of the Canadian Council on Animal Care (CCAC). The Committee is responsible for ensuring ethical conduct for the care and use of animals in research and teaching activities involving YukonU. All activities involving animals must receive ethics clearance by the Animal Care Committee (ACC) prior to the start of the project. The ACC meets 3 to 4 times a year and reviews 2 or 3 projects.



Eligible students should:

- be enrolled in full-time studies at Yukon University
- have an interest in animal care and welfare
- respect the confidentiality of ACC matters
- attend all ACC meetings
- be willing to learn about requirements for animal care and use in research and teaching

Students are appointed as volunteer members for 1 year. No prior experience is necessary, information and training are provided.
