



## Retrieving Reviews In EBSCO Databases

1. Log in to Academic Search Complete.
2. Click on "Choose Databases" (blue lettering above search box).
3. From the pop-up window, click on the option "Select / deselect All" to select all of the databases.
4. Click the "OK" button to return to the search screen.
5. Type the name of the author(s) of the original work you wish to find reviews for. Use the *name last name* format. Example: Joseph Boyden (NOT Boyden, Joseph)
6. Click the "Search" button.
7. The result screen will appear. To save time going through the results, limit those results to **Reviews** only.

8. The revised result list will show only those articles that are reviews of works by your intended author.
