### Pre-Existing condition

 Physiological (e..g immunocompromised, diabetes, lung or heart conditions, or conditions that affect immune function, kidney/liver disease, cancer etc.)

#### Social Factors

- Individuals with insecure, inadequate or overcrowded housing conditions
- Individuals that live in group settings
- social or geographic isolation (remote locations)
- difficulty accessing medical care or health advice.
