

Campus Housing COVID-19 measures

Occupants are required to follow all Yukon Government Public Health Measures (including the SAFE 6) as well as any other health and safety measures implemented by Yukon University, such as those below. All health and safety measures are considered part of the Housing Contract and subject to discipline for failing to comply. Institutional measures are reviewed regularly and updates regarding any changes will be communicated via email.

Campus Housing COVID-19 measures

- Hand sanitization - All persons must sanitize their hands upon entering Campus Housing buildings.
- Guest Restrictions - Restrictions of two consistent guests per occupant; guests must be registered and signed in.
- Physical distancing - All persons are to remain 6ft. apart at all times.
- Masks - Masks are mandatory in all common areas of Campus Housing buildings. Occupants are not required to wear a mask inside their units.
- Space capacity - Occupants must adhere to maximum capacities set for each common space (posted on doors).
- Disinfecting - Campus Housing Staff disinfect high-touch points twice daily and occupants are required to disinfect shared food prep areas after each use.
- Dorm kitchens - Occupants must only eat in their Units or lounges and refrain from eating in the designated food prep areas.
- Dorm washrooms/bathrooms - Occupants must only use the Washrooms/Bathrooms to which they are assigned.
